



Directions to Hamilton's Tented Camp

GPS Co-ordinates can be inaccurate please follow below directions:

ORPEN GATE ENTRY

(Estimated Driving Time: 1.5 - 2 hours)

- Take the H7 towards Satara
- Drive for approximately 6.7km
- Turn right onto the S106 (Dirt Road)
- After 1.6km, turn right onto the S140 towards Talamati
- After 19.5km, turn right onto the S145
- For Hamilton's Tented Camp continue straight along S145 for a further 2.3kms, you will reach a T-junction, turn right onto the S36
- 6.5kms further the road forks, keep right (follow the Hamilton's Tented Camp signage and proceed through the no entry sign)
- Carry on along this road for 2kms, going through a low water bridge
- Approximately 400 meters after the low water bridge turn right at the no entry sign
- Take the first road to your right and you will find Hamilton's Tented Camp.

KRUGER GATE ENTRY

(Estimated Driving Time: 2.5 - 3 hours)

- Take the H1-2 towards Skukuza
- Pass Skukuza and take the H11 towards Satara
- After approximately 20kms turn left onto the S36 (Dirt Road), it is signposted. Carry on along the S36 for approximately 39kms
- You will reach a no entry sign for Hamilton's Tented Camp guests only, for Hamilton's Tented Camp proceed through the no entry. A further 200m you will reach a second no entry sign, turn left.
- Thereafter, take the first road to your right and you will find Hamilton's Tented Camp.

HOEDSPRUIT – ORPEN

(Estimated Driving Time: 1½ hours)

- Take the R40 from Hoedspruit towards Klaserie
- After approximately 23km turn left, stay on the R40 towards Acornhoek
- After approximately 3km, turn left onto the Orpen Gate Road (R531) • After 40km you will reach the Orpen Gate of the Kruger National Park.

SKUKUZA AIRPORT TO HAMILTON’S TENTED CAMP

(Estimated Driving Time: 2 ½ hours)

- Follow the exit road from the airport
- At the T-junction turn left towards Satara, H1-2 (tar road).
- After approximately 20kms turn left onto the S36 (Dirt Road), it is signposted. Carry on along the S36 for approximately 39kms
- You will reach a no entry sign for Hamilton’s Tented Camp guests only, for Hamilton’s Tented Camp proceed through the no entry. A further 200m you will reach a second no entry sign, turn left.
- Thereafter, take the first road to your right and you will find Hamilton’s Tented Camp.

KRUGER MPUMALANGA INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT – PAUL KRUGER GATE

(Estimated Driving Time: 3 hours)

- After exiting the airport follow the R538 north towards White River
- From White River follow the R40 towards Hazyview
- In Hazyview turn right at the second traffic light onto the R536
- Follow the R536 straight to Paul Kruger Gate of the Kruger National Park.

KRUGER MPUMALANGA INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT – ORPEN

(Estimated Driving Time: 3- 4 hours)

- After exiting the airport follow the R538 north towards White River
- From White River follow the R538 towards Hazyview
- From Hazyview follow R40 towards Bushbuckridge
- Drive through Bushbuckridge and Acornhoek remaining on the R40
- Turn right onto the R531 Orpen Gate road
- After 40km you will reach the Orpen Gate of the Kruger National Park.

TRANSFERS

Please note that we are delighted to arrange a transfer on finalization of your reservation with our preferred transfer company. Kindly send us your flight details, should you wish for us to book a transfer for you and we will gladly add this onto your Proforma Invoice.

Gate Entrance Times:

Please be aware of gate entrance times into Kruger National Park as they do vary throughout the year, depending on the season. Entrance into the park via Orpen Gate should be no later than **two hours** prior to gate closure time and via Kruger Gate should be no later than **three hours** prior to gate closure time.

Gate Opening Times:

October – March 05h30
April – September 06h00

Gate Closing Times:

November – February 18h30
March - April 18h00
May – July 17h30
August – October 18h00

Conservation Fees:

A conservation fee of R97.00 per person is payable at the gate of entry when self-driving. Guest arriving at the lodge with a transfer vehicle will be charged at reception.

Speed Limit:

Whilst driving within the Kruger National Park, please adhere to the legal speed limit of 50km per hour on tarred roads and 40km per hour on dirt roads.

Safety Precautions:

Please adhere to the Kruger National Park safety precautions, and do not disembark from your vehicle unless you are in a designated area.

Cellular Phone Coverage:

Cellular phone signal is only available at the entrance gates and close to Skukuza, it is therefore recommended to make your last necessary calls at the gate upon entry.

Seasons:

Kruger experiences winter and summer at the opposite times as Europe and North America. The wet summer months (October to April) are hot and often humid. Dry winters (May to September) are warm and mild although it cools off considerably at night. It is advisable to take warm clothing for early morning and evening game drives. During the Wet season, it rarely rains all day, but afternoon thundershowers are common.

Perfect safari packing:

Tight fitting sun hat, cap or beanie in Winter (it gets quite windy on an open safari vehicle)

Light jacket (and fleece in Winter)

Lightweight cotton or linen shirts and shorts

Tracksuit or warm longs

Closed shoes and socks

Comfortable open sandals

Camera, spare batteries and memory card

Binoculars

A stick of mosquito repellent
