All you need to know about the Norway Ferry System

You cannot reserve the ferries that are just an extension of the main road system. You drive to the dock, wait in line and board the next ferry. You can for example see the ferry crossings on Google Maps.

Find your ferry

For other ferries just Google 'ferry' and the names of the docks (as shown on GoogleMaps). ie, Googling 'Ferry Halsa" should find you the information on that ferry. You might have to use the correct Norwegian spelling with æ, ø & å!

Timetables

Look up the departure time in the time table and allow yourself some extra time to buy the ticket. Normally the ferry has enough space for the cars that are waiting. Only on Sundays, the ferry might be more busy and we advise you to arrive a little earlier.

Ticket price

A ticket for a ferry ride with a car automatically includes one adult, the driver, additional passenger can be added.
