ROUTE 2: Visa on arrival process and details

We strongly encourage all of our guests to arrange their visa for the Republic of Congo prior to arrival. If you elect to follow Route 2 (only recommended for countries with no Consular services for Republic of Congo) and get a visa for Republic of Congo on arrival, please notify our team when booking and carefully note the below:

ROUTE 2: VISA ON ARRIVAL

- A visa on arrival is a special arrangement available by courtesy of the Congolese government for our guests. This can cause confusion with 3rd parties such as international airlines while travelling as our arrangement is not widely known or available, nor is it the preferred visa route by Congolese officials.
- As you have been unable to obtain a visa prior to arrival, it is important to note your application for a Letter of Invitation may take longer.
- If you arrive at Maya Maya Airport without your Letter of Invitation and/or Visa Assistance Letter, immigration challenges will occur and penalties may apply upwards of US\$ 50 (no change will be available at border control; penalties additional to Visa on Arrival fees).


- Visas on arrival may result in your passport being retained overnight. This is not unusual and we will collect it in the morning and return it to you at the earliest possible time.
- If paying for visas or forgotten Letters of Invitation on arrival, only US\$ bills are accepted, and bills issued before 2013 will not be accepted.
- At Maya Maya Airport (Brazzaville), you will need to fill in an immigration form and present your Yellow Fever certificate. Let the officials know you are visiting Odzala Discovery Camps and require a Visa on Arrival. Have your Letter of Invitation and Visa Assistance Letter ready. The officials will lead you through the process.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION

- Passport to be valid 6 months after arrival date
- Minimum of 1 blank page in your passport (amendment pages do not apply)
- 2 copies of a Visa Assistance Letter

- 2 copies of your Letter of Invitation
- Visa cost: US\$ 50 cash (2013 bills or later) No change will be available
- Yellow Fever certificate of vaccination

PLEASE NOTE We cannot guarantee processing times of Letters of Invitation or visas, this process is managed by the Congolese government and is outside of our control. Congo Conservation Company will not be liable for any issues should they occur during application/travel.

Preparing for arrival at Maya Maya International - Brazzaville

We cannot wait to welcome you to our camps soon! To help you prepare for arrival at Republic of Congo's international airport in Brazzaville, please read below to guide you on what to double check before you leave home and what to expect upon arrival.

Letter of Invitation (LOI): Visa prior to arrival - 1 copy Visa on arrival - 3 copies	
Visa Assistance Letter: Visa on arrival only - 3 copies	
Passport (with your visa if not on arrival) valid for 6 months after departure date	
International yellow fever vaccination certificate	
A pen to fill in the immigration form on arrival	

WHAT TO EXPECT AT MAYA MAYA INTERNATIONAL

Route 1 VISA PRIOR TO ARRIVAL

- Immigration forms are to be completed on arrival.
- Have a hard copy of your LOI readily available.
- Present your yellow fever certificate and passport with your visa to the officials.
- Continue to baggage claim and customs, we will be waiting for you in the arrival hall.

REMINDER FOR ROUTE 2 GUESTS

- A visa on arrival is a courtesy by special arrangement with the Congolese government for our guests. This can cause confusion with 3rd parties such as international airlines while travelling.
- It is not uncommon for your passport to be retained overnight - we will return it to you as soon as possible.

Route 2 visa on arrival in Brazzaville

- Immigration forms are to be completed on arrival.
- Have 3 hard copies of you LOI and 3 hard copies of your Visa Assistance Letter readily available.
- On arrival and after completing the immigration form, an official will call for all 'Visa on Arrival' applicants.
- Present your Yellow Fever certificate, and give your passport, a copy of your LOI and Visa Assistance Letter to the official.
- Follow the official through the airport to process your application (US\$ 50 no change will be available).
- Continue to baggage claim and customs, we will be waiting for you in the arrival hall.
- If you arrive at Maya Maya Airport without your LOI and/or Visa Assistance Letter, you will encounter immigration challenges and be charged a penalty upwards of US\$ 50 (no change is available).
- If paying for visas or forgotten documents on arrival, only US\$ bills issued in 2013 and later are accepted.
