Ozala Discovery Camps - Ngaga Camp



ESSENCE

Towering trees, dense marantaceae, dappled sunlight, the scent of fresh rain and delicate sounds of an equatorial African rainforest surround you.

LOCATION

- Located in the Ndzehi Forest on the western boundary of Odzala-Kokoua National Park.

ABOUT THE CAMP

- 6 double chalets are found nestled on stilts in the dense forest overlooking the Ndezhi Forest.
- These unique rooms were constructed from natural materials such as locally woven raffia palm panels.
- The dining room, lounge and bar area are raised and gaze into the rainforest.
- Our star deck and fire pit are found on a deck below the main living area for pre-dinner drinks while you watch the sun set over the forest.
- A river deck is located on the Ngaga stream for post forest walk drinks and special occasions.

CHALET DETAILS

- Raised 3-4 meters above the ground.
- A 360° wraparound walkway.
- En-suite bathroom: hot shower and flush toilet.
- Mosquito net.
- Environmentally friendly soaps and shampoos.
- Fans and SA power points with European and UK adapters (no air-conditioning).

WHAT YOU MIGHT SEE

- Western Lowland Gorillas
3 groups are habituated with 2 families available on the Observer Permits. The 3rd group is only obtainable on the Researcher Permit (please enquire for information).

Please note: while every effort is made, gorilla viewing cannot be guaranteed

- Moustached Monkey
- Palm civets
- A species of Galago
- Forest duikers
- Black-casqued Wattled Hornbill
- Great Blue Turaco (rare)

ACTIVITIES

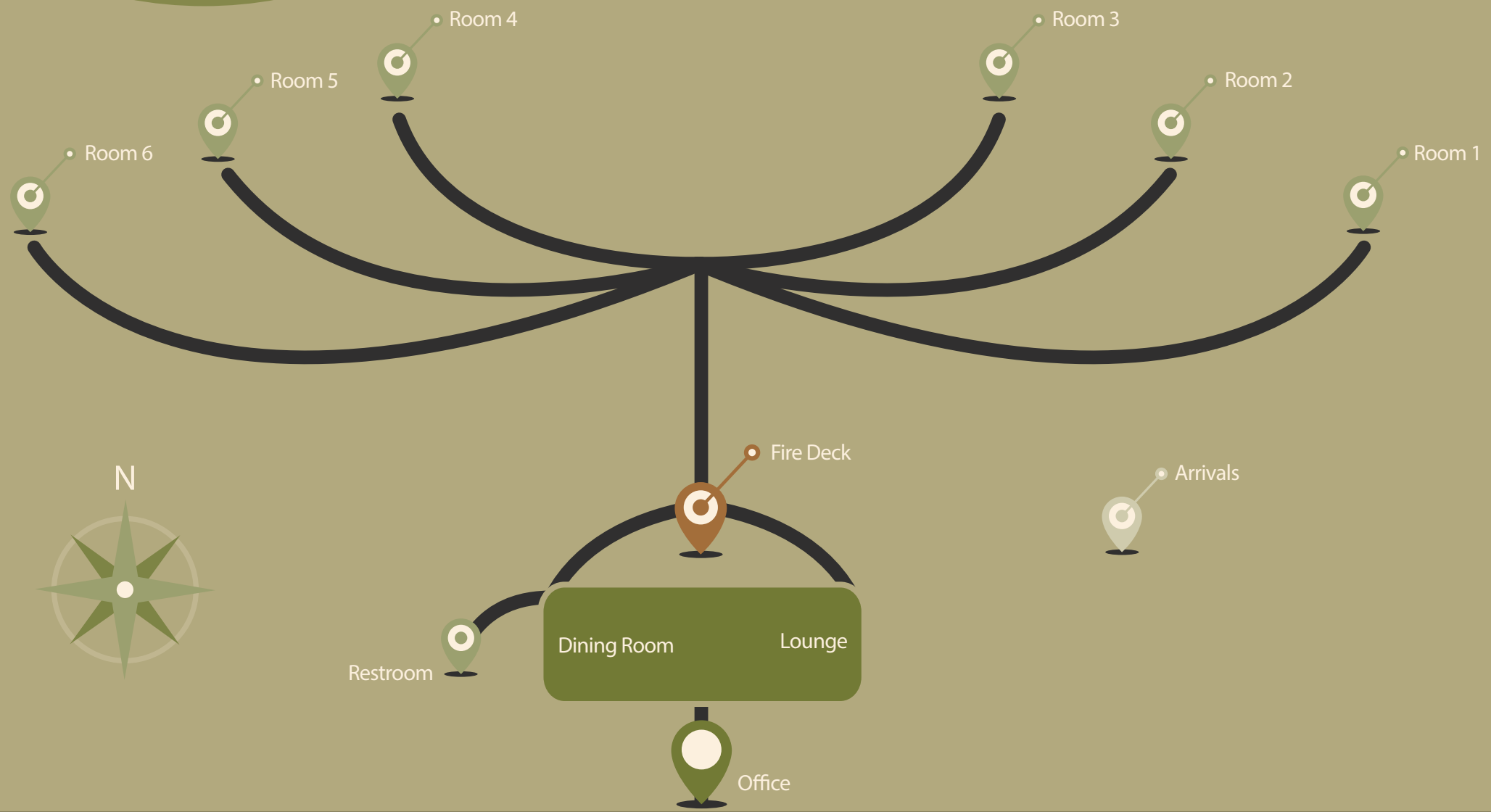
Ngaga Camp is home to our research team who have spent the last few decades in the forest navigating its trails and understanding its rhythms.

Guests come here to share in their knowledge and experience this intact rainforest. Forest walks, night walks, night drives and more are available.

GUIDE TIP

Track Western Lowland Gorillas respectfully with our research trackers and guides, observe gorillas behaviours and see them in context of their forest.

Ozala Discovery Camps - Lango Camp



ESSENCE

Time at Lango Camp is about getting wet, getting muddy and getting in touch with this pristine landscape which features a network of streams, baï, forest and pockets of savannah.

LOCATION

- Located in the south central part of the park allowing easy access to a variety of habitats.

ABOUT THE CAMP

- 6 double chalets are found nestled on stilts in the dense forest overlooking Lango Baï.
- These unique chalets were constructed from natural materials such as locally woven raffia palm panels.
- The camp is connected by a series of raised walkways creating a treehouse-like atmosphere.
- A dining room, lounge and bar area are found on the main deck overlooking the baï.
- Our star deck and fire pit are perfectly positioned for pre-dinner drinks to watch the sunset and, simply, to relax.

CHALET DETAILS

- Raised 3-4 meters above the ground.
- A 360° wraparound walkway.
- En-suite bathroom: hot shower and flush toilet.
- Mosquito net.
- Environmentally friendly soaps and shampoos.
- Fans and SA power points with European and UK adapters (no air-conditioning).

EXPERIENCE CONGO

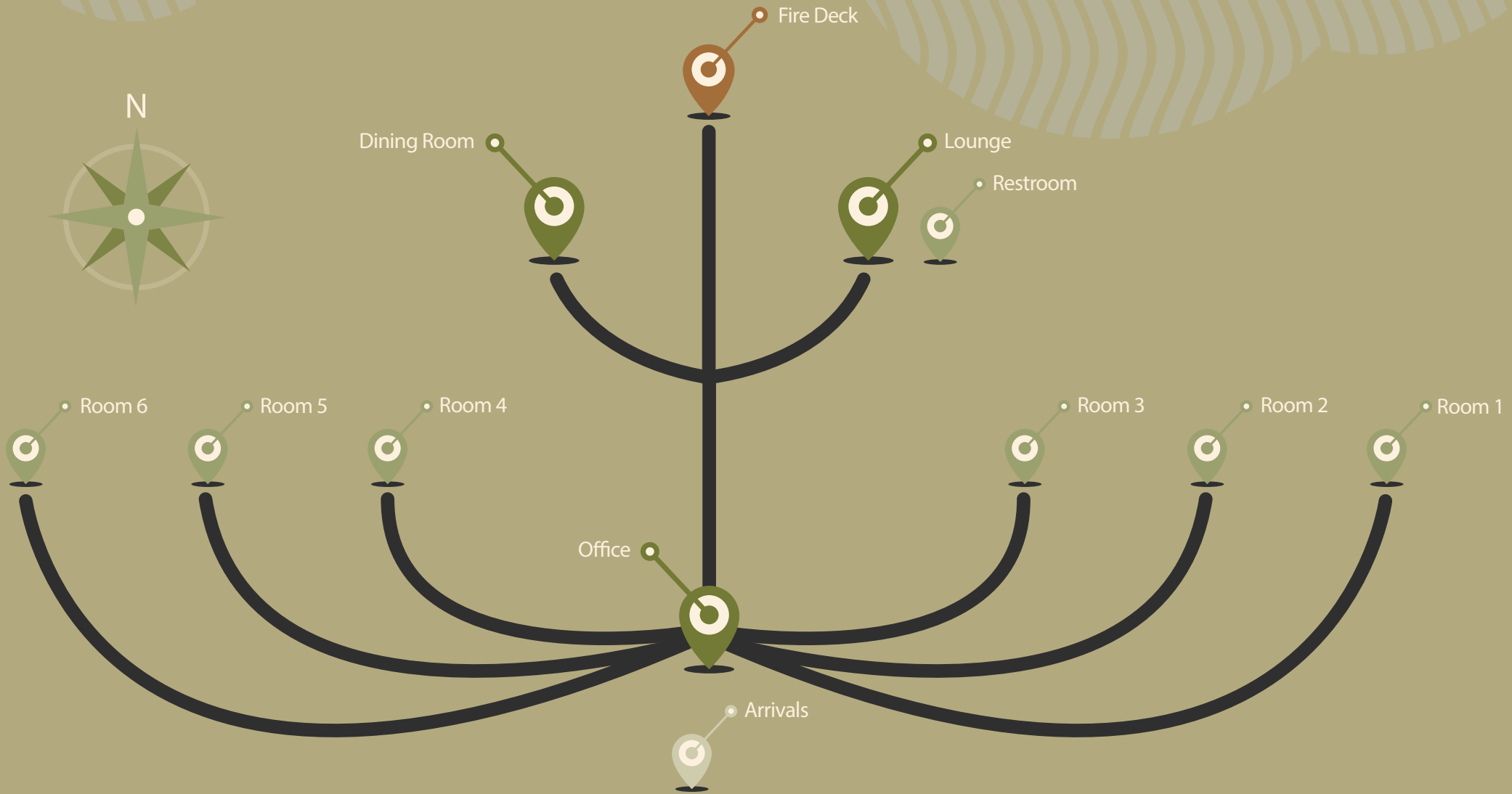
Activities from Lango Camp focus on the baï, Lekoli River and surrounding areas with long and short walks through the various biomes (short drives may be required to get from one place to the next).

ESSENCE

The combination of wide open grasslands, rivers and forest result in a kind of magical calm. Its peace washes over you, leaving you open to receive what the forest wants to share with you.

LOCATION

- Located inside Odzala-Kokoua National Park and the closest of the camps to our private airstrip.

ABOUT THE CAMP

- 10 double cabins and 2 family cabins (4 guests) are dotted along the Likeni River in the tree line.
- The aging termite mounds are the calling card of Mboko and fleck the landscape.
- The dining room, lounge and bar area look out into the wide-open grasslands.
- Our star deck and fire pit are an extension of the living areas, the ideal space for pre-dinner drinks and to watch lightning on the horizon (if you're lucky - the displays can be quite epic).
- A river deck is located along the Likeni River for post forest walk drinks or special occasions.

CABIN DETAILS

- Each spacious cabin has a private deck with seating and a view of either the forest or river.
- En-suite bathroom: hot shower and flush toilet.
- Mosquito net.
- Environmentally friendly soaps and shampoos.
- Fans and European power points (no air-conditioning).

EXPERIENCE CONGO

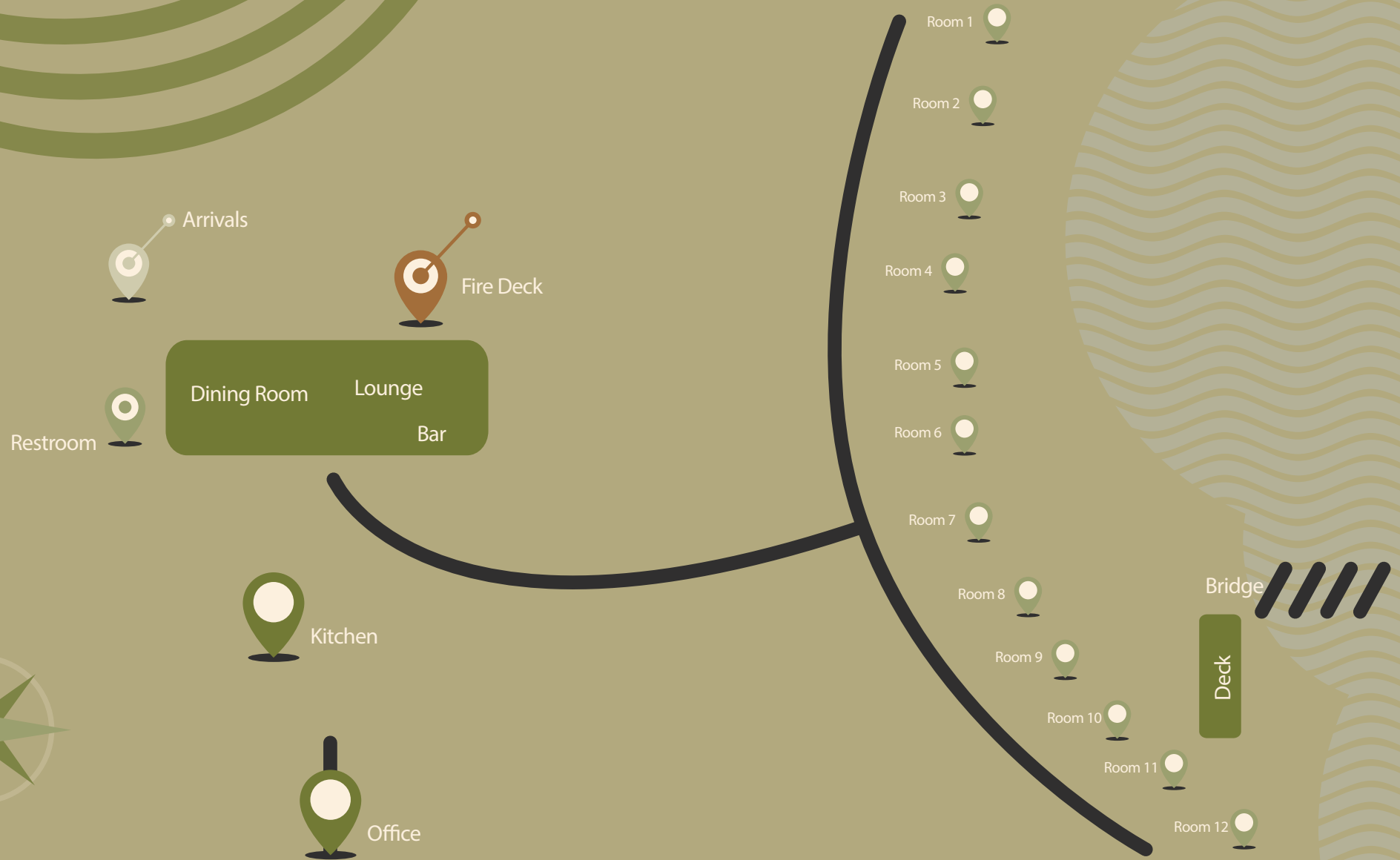
Mboko Camp is the home of adventure. The activities here are a combination of walking, boating and kayaking through some of the Congo Basin's most beautiful habitats. Short drives may be required to get from one place to another.

Explore the Lekoli River in either our aluminum boat (complete with cushioned seats and awning) or kayaks, then go ahead on foot deeper into the forest or explore baïa further afield.

Ozala Discovery Camps - General Information



CHILD POLICY

- Children of 16 years and older are welcome at Odzala Discovery Camps.
- Guests are responsible for their children and themselves as the camps are unfenced in a wildlife area.

ELECTRICITY & WATER

- 24-hour electricity is provided by solar energy with a back-up generator if required.
- Water provided has been filtered through our on-site system.
- European plugs are available throughout.
- Hairdryers and flat irons are restricted.

WI-FI

- Limited Wi-Fi is available at each camp and is dependent on weather.
- We ask that guests use the connection mindfully during business hours.

DINING

- Our chefs create a different menu for each day during your stay.
- Please inform us of any dietary concerns at least 1 week prior to arrival.

DRINKS

- House drinks are included throughout your stay.
- Water, coffee and tea are provided daily.
- Imported premium wines, spirits and champagnes are available to purchase in camp.

LAUNDRY

- Daily laundry is included in each stay. Please note that due to the humid conditions, drying times may be longer than expected.

TIPPING GUIDELINE

- Guides - US\$ 20 per day
- Trackers - US\$ 10 per trek
- Camps - US\$ 20 per guest per day
- This is only a guide, gratuities remain at the discretion of our guests.
- Gratuity boxes are available at each camp upon check-out.

EXTRA PURCHASES

- Payment of any extras (additional trekking permits, premium drinks etc.) can be settled in cash (USD, Euro, or XAF).
- Please note that there are no credit card payment facilities at the camps, and Traveller's Cheques are not accepted.

TRANSFERS

- Scheduled charter flights between Brazzaville and Mboko Airstrip are available on Mondays and Thursdays weekly.
- Private charters are available Friday - Sunday and Tuesday - Wednesday for up to 12 guests.
- 12kg luggage restriction may apply to charters (we will send any restrictions prior to arrival).
- Road transfers are available Monday - Saturday (14hrs from Brazzaville to our camps).
