Passport and visa info

American & Canadian citizens need to get a visa to visit Zambia. This visa can be purchased on arrival for 50USD (subject to change). It is a pretty quick and simple process.

Visitors to Africa must have a passport that is valid for at least 6 months beyond their intended departure date. Each country you visit generally requires at least 3 consecutive/side by side blank pages on entry for both visas and stamps. Should there be insufficient blank visa pages in the passport then entry into a country could be denied.

Covid Testing

To enter Zambia you no longer need a covid test. Please check with your airline to see if they require a covid test or proof of vaccination in order to fly.

Bugs

As you know, Africa has bugs. We are visiting Zambia in June which is the start of the winter season so Mosquitos will be less prevalent. Having said that I would still take profalactics for Malaria. Zambia is also known for its Tsetse flies. You also get these flies when visiting Kenya and Tanzania. They are most prevalent in woodland areas which we will be avoiding but I cant promise that you will not see a Tsetse fly. We will of course travel with all the necessary bug deterrents on the trip.

Health Requirements

Malaria is a threat in most African countries so precautions must be taken. You are travelling in our Autumn time which is a change in season. I suggest you contact your doctor for advice.

The government of South African, Botswana, Zimbabwe and Zambia requires proof of yellow fever vaccination only if you are arriving from a country with risk of yellow fever. This does not include Canada or the USA. If you are traveling from a country other than the US, check this list to see if you may be required to get the yellow fever vaccine: [Countries with risk of yellow fever virus \(YFV\) transmission](#).

Wi-Fi

Wi-Fi is available throughout your trip. Remember that on Safari wifi the connection may be slow and frustrating. I suggest you switch off while on safari ... if you can☺. It's amazing to immerse yourself in the bush and cut yourself off from the real world for a few days, not many people have the opportunity to do so.

Hairdryer

There is no need to pack a hairdryer for your trip. It takes up a lot of much needed space and the camps wont have the correct power needs for it. There are hairdryers in your rooms at each camp – these are specifically made to work on the solar power generated by the camp.

Luggage

Please remember that we will be flying on small charter flights which have a strict 15Kg luggage restriction for cabin luggage and 5Kgs for hand luggage. My advice is to travel light as too much

luggage is hard to move around with. There is a strict luggage restriction for all guests travelling by light aircraft transfers of 20kg (44lbs), 25cm (10 inches) wide x 30cm (12 inches) high and 65cm (26 inches) long per person in soft, manageable bags which may have one rigid side, this includes hand baggage and camera equipment.

Please tag your luggage with your name and contact details and keep your passport on you when travelling as you will need it to check-in to flights and at hotel receptions.

Laundry

You are able to do Laundry throughout your trip and is included in the camp nightly rate.

Gratuities

I have costed this into the trip price as I don't want you to worry about anything on your holiday. Leave the gratuity to us. We will ensure that all staff are taken care of. If you feel that you would like to contribute more to a specific staff member please feel free to do so.

Power

In Zambia the power plug sockets are of type C, D and G. Check out the following pictures.

- Type C: also known as the standard "Euro" plug. This socket also works with plug E and plug F.
- Type D: mainly used in India, Sri Lanka, Nepal, and some African countries. This socket only works with plug D.
- Type G: this type is of British origin. This socket only works with plug G.
