

Flights and Baggage (within Africa)

- Bags must be soft sided (duffel-style and backpacks). Rolling duffels with no rigid frames are accepted.
- Weight and dimension of bags is crucial, particularly for light aircraft and charter flights (see below for details).
- Maximum weight allowances are inclusive of carry-on, checked baggage and camera equipment.
- In some cases, you may purchase an extra seat or a special class of service to account for excess baggage weight. Ask us for details!
- Remember to pack lightly! Laundry can be done on safari at most camps on a complimentary basis or for a small cost.

Typical Weight Allowances

- Commercial flights within Africa maximum baggage allowance is typically 44 lbs. per person.
- Light aircraft/charter flights can vary:
 - Within East Africa and Namibia 33 lbs. per person
 - South Africa and Botswana 44 lbs. per person
 - Zimbabwe 33 lbs. or 44 lbs. per person (dependent on airline)
 - Zambia 50 lbs per person
- Dimensions of the bag should be no larger than: 70 cm x 60 cm x 35 cm (L x W x D) 27" x 24" x 14"

Suggested Baggage Types

Examples: Eagle Creek Cargo-Hauler-Wheeled-Duffel-110L or similar, plus a strong, weather resistant backpack:
