Forms can be downloaded from our website. Payments can be paid by check or credit card; unless special circumstances apply. Borton can assist you with flights and these will be arranged on separate terms.



(Theck travel documents and entry requirements for your itinerary

PASSPORT: You will need a valid passport that will be valid at least 6 months after your return date. You should have at least 2 blank VISA pages available for entry / visa stamps into EACH country you are visiting (amendment, endorsement pages and inside back cover cannot be used for visa stamps). Our website lists helpful sites for your trip preparation, including the National Passport Center website, in which you can print off forms for passport renewal. ENTRY VISAS: Check with your agent for current entry requirements for each country that you plan to visit. This should be done at least 3 months before traveling, especially if you are visiting several countries. Most countries allow travelers to purchase these visas upon arrival at the airport. If pre-arranged visas are recommended, you will need to send your passport to the proper embassies or a visa service to obtain the visa stamps. Duke's Visa Service in Washington DC offers you an easy way to obtain visas before you depart on your journey. Physician statement for Kilimanjaro Climbers

For those planning to climb Mt. Kilimanjaro or partake in any other type of strenuous activities on safari, you are required to submit to Borton Overseas, our physician statement form, to be completed by your doctor stating that you are in good health for the activity planned. This letter is to be submitted to Borton not later than final payment.

Check your vaccinations

Consult your physician several months before departure as some vaccinations cannot be given with others or may need time to become effective. A Yellow Fever vaccination certificate may be required for entry, if you are coming from an endemic country. E.g. it is required if you are visiting both Kenya and Tanzania. Even if you are just connecting through the Nairobi airport, you will be required to have this to enter Tanzania. It may also be required if you are traveling through various Southern African countries. This vaccination needs to be received a minimum of 10 days prior to entry into Africa and is good for a lifetime. The Yellow Fever endemic list changes so please consult your travel clinic and/or visit www.cdc.gov/travel

The CDC in Atlanta recommends the following precautions for travelers to East and Southern Africa:

(Note that some are dependent on locations to be visited, planned activities and health of traveler)

- Malaria prevention
- Hepatitis A and B
- Tetanus and Polio boosters

- Meningitis
 - Typhoid
