In 1957, three surgeons founded the Flying Doctors Service of East Africa, laying the foundation for what is now one of the continent's leading health development and research organizations. Today, AMREF implements its projects and charity evacuations throughout Africa.

Running one of the most comprehensive air ambulance services in Africa, AMREF evacuates approximately 600 people annually. It is the only air ambulance rescue service with its own permanent professional medics, pilots, intensive care air ambulances, and a radio communication network linked to over 120 stations spread throughout East Africa and manned 24/7.

AMREF offers an air ambulance rescue service to tourist members for up to 1,000 km radius from Nairobi's Wilson Airport. This also covers the road transportation by ambulance from Nairobi's Wilson Airport to Nairobi Hospital.

In case of a medical emergency while on safari, AMREF Flying Doctors will be contacted immediately to carry out a bush evacuation. AMREF membership will ensure minimal response time and avoids any delays associated with international insurance guarantees.

It is Cheli & Peacock Safaris' policy that all of our clients must be registered with AMREF; therefore a compulsory AMREF membership fee is included in every client quotation.

AMREF MEMBERSHIP FEES

AREA 1: US\$ 7.00 for air ambulance coverage for Kenya, Tanzania and Zanzibar for up to 30 days.

AREA 2: US\$ 11.00 for air ambulance coverage for East African (Kenya, Tanzania, Uganda, Rwanda and Burundi for up to 30 days.

Tourists not covered by the AMREF membership will be liable to meet full flight costs and any other expenses occurred during the evacuation process.
