The GWF has recently embarked on a programme aimed at creating Digital Learning Centres in the neighbouring rural areas of Londolozi with the intention of promoting digital numeracy and English literacy including instruction in a variety of practical skills training such as sewing and appropriate agriculture. All GWF programmes instil in the individual core values such as ethics and environmental care.

The core objective of these Learning Centres will be to interface advanced learning techniques with rural students to provide unprecedented levels of digital excellence capability. To achieve this objective, gwf will draw on the ever improving world connectivity which is now available in all parts of Southern Africa.

The flexible structures of the Centres will mean that they are able to adopt new teaching techniques and up to date information technology as soon as it becomes available. The Centres will, therefore, be nimble and able to provide curriculums for students drawing on the latest online educational information available around the world. This innovative 'leapfrog' approach levels the playing fields for the possibilities of learning in rural Africa and is represented at the following specific Centres, which you are invited to visit at your leisure.

GWF PRESCHOOLS

Early Learning

The good work foundation is involved in a number of preschools in rural South Africa. Education is never as important as it is in the first few years of a child's schooling. A happy, nurturing beginning means children who love to learn and are excited about their futures. By equipping our preschools and training our teachers the good work foundation children receive a great start and they are set apart from their peers in the school years that follow.

GWF SCHOLARSHIPS

Supporting African Greatness

Through our work in our Digital Learning Centres we work with many young people. We are amazed everyday by the latent talent of our rural learners and have a number of young people being given scholarships to attend great schools. The good work foundation also gives opportunity to those learners who have participated and excelled both at school and in our programmes, awarding scholarships (partial and full) to learners studying at a tertiary level. We have students studying IT, Education, Marketing, Tourism, Admin, Engineering.

GWF DIGITAL LEARNING CENTRE

Access Excellence

Hazyview 1 hr from Londolozi (no extra cost for community trips)

This is the management hub for all the satellite learning centres and is staffed by recently retired schoolteachers, visiting international graduates (whilst on their Africa 'tour of duty') and past Londolozi guests wishing to contribute personally to this endeavour. The Centre connects, on a daily basis, between 500 and 1000 students of all ages to the world of digital learning via the internet. It is a model for Africa-centric rural education and learning that will provide 'leapfrog' education to rural Africans commensurate with anything currently available in the world.

GWF DIGITAL LEARNING CENTRE

Access Excellence

Madlala 30 Minute Drive from Londolozi (no extra cost for community trips)

The centre provides education in our four key areas to students of the local neighbouring high schools in Justicia (i.e. a community school adjacent to Londolozi). Digital and English literacy classes form the bulk of the curriculum with environment, creativity and leadership skills also being taught. The Centre is run by trained young graduates of the Learning Centre drawn from the community and the Centre functions as a viable business, charging the students a fee. This innovative approach ensures the sustainability of this enduring business model. The Madlala Learning Centre is a satellite operation managed and funded from the central learning centre hub based in the town of Hazyview, 80km from.

By choosing Londolozi you make a contribution to the education and empowerment of many people living and working in the rural areas surrounding us. Londolozi has been in community development for some 35 years and through many lessons learnt we have partnered with the Good Work Foundation. Why?
