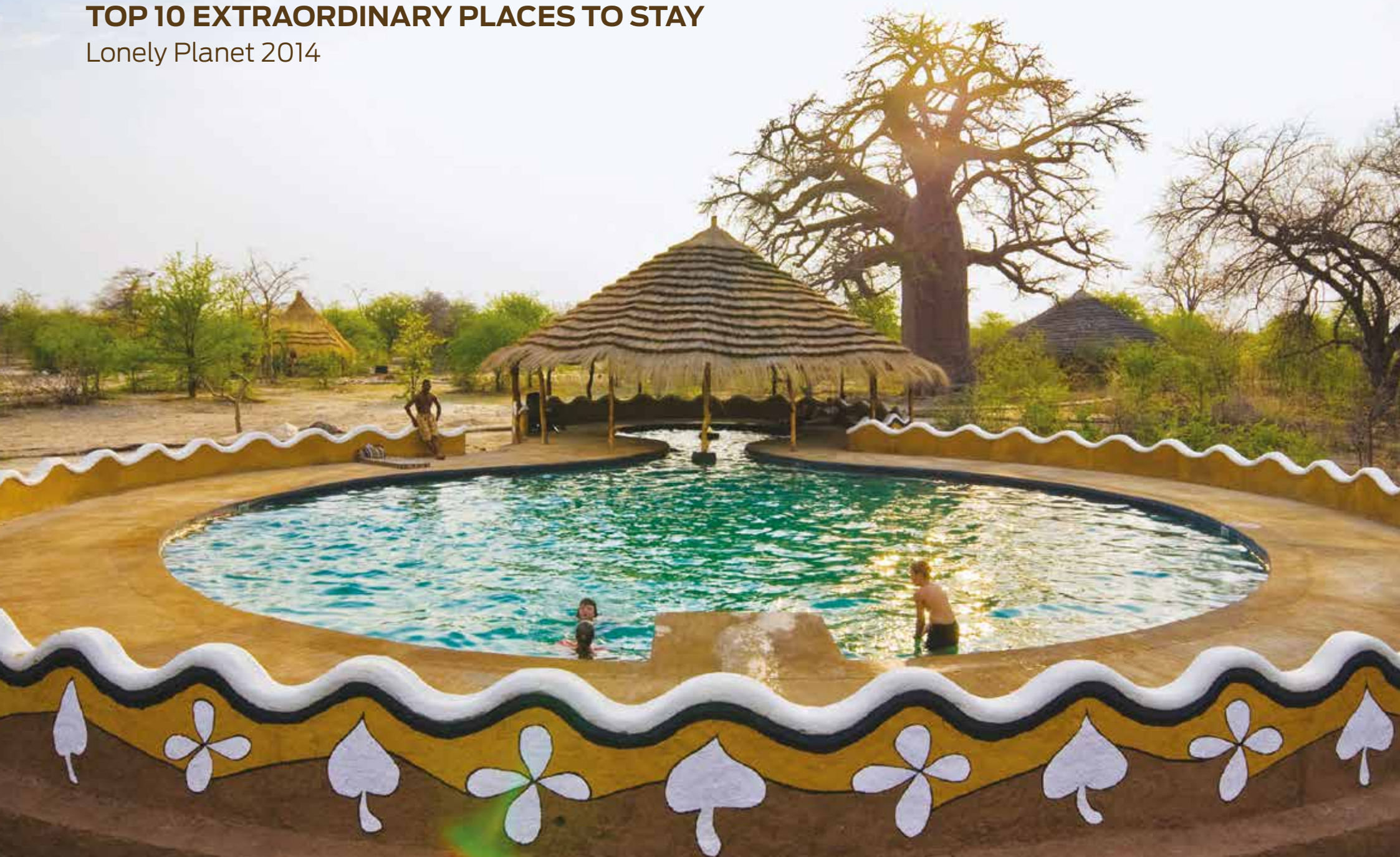
What are the facilities at PB?

Central double bed with two single beds on either side. En-suite bathrooms.
- **8 Twin Bakalanga Huts** (sleep 2).
Two single beds on either side of the hut. En-suite bathrooms.

When is a good time to go?

OPEN ALL YEAR ROUND

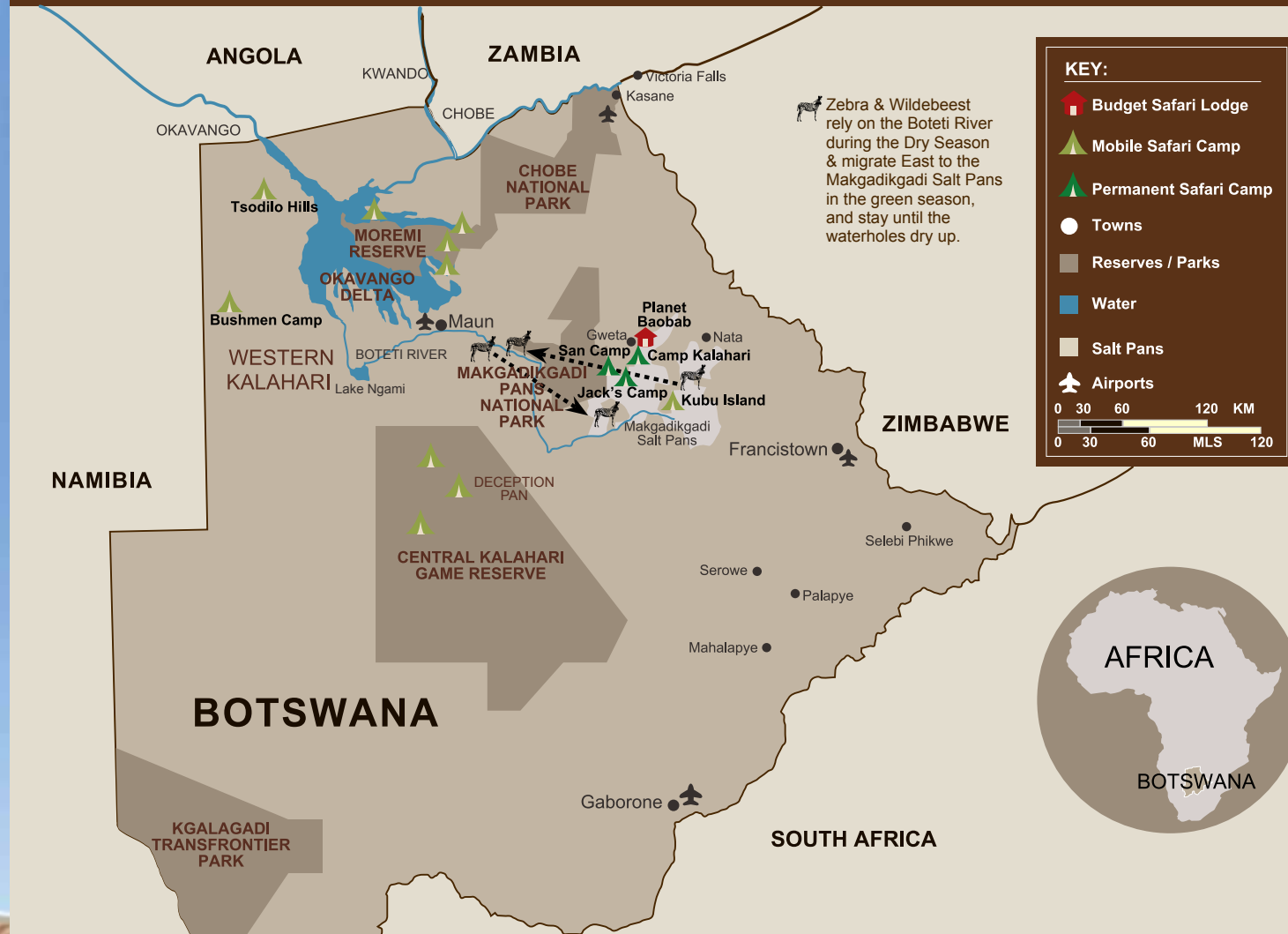
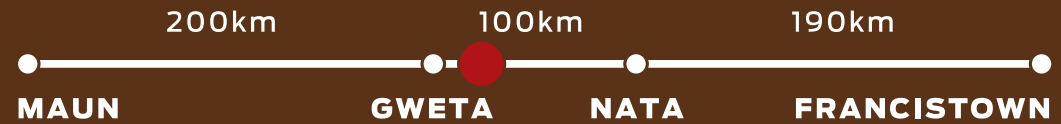
DRY SEASON (Winter): 25th Apr – 31st Oct

GREEN SEASON (Summer): 1st Nov – 24th Apr

Activities are weather dependent.

How do I get there?

- Drive yourself to Planet Baobab.
- PB is accessible by two wheel drive.
- Look out for the Giant Aardvark, 200kms from Maun & 100kms from Nata.
- Road transfers are available from Maun & Gweta.
- Fly from Maun to Gweta.
