


INTRODUCTION




INTRODUCTION

The main purpose of Jukani is to change people's perception of these animals whether it is fear, hate, indifference, despise or worse the need to humanise (touch, play, cuddle, walk on leash, be photographed with).

There is after all ZERO conservation value in animal touching and the pet, play and pay practice so many attractions promote aggressively is simply and sadly wrong.

The animals at Jukani are all wild - none of them has had their spirits broken and none have been tamed.

INTRODUCTION

Monkeyland is the worlds first free roaming multi-specie primate sanctuary, Monkeyland has as one of its aims, to create awareness about the plight of primates and to show that with a greater understanding of our primate cousins, that we can all live in harmony.

Monkeyland was the brainchild of Tony Blignaut whose dream was to create a forest sanctuary that restored the freedom of ex-captive primates.

Monkeyland's forest encompasses a 12 hectare sanctuary together with a 13 hectare 'greenbelt' area which is protected for indigenous Baboons, Vervet Monkeys and other wildlife. The sanctuary is home to more than 550 primates.




INTRODUCTION

Join us on a 1 hour guided tour to visit the indigenous Wild Cats of South Africa and other wildlife at Tenikwa in Plettenberg Bay. You will see Leopard, Cheetahs, Serval, Caracal, African Wildcat, penguins and more. This is a unique opportunity to get close to some amazing creatures, and learn about their struggle to survive in the wild.

To fund the rehabilitation work and to raise awareness of the conservation issues in South Africa, Tenikwa offers various, small group programs throughout the day, catering for all ages and fitness levels with a focus on providing a conservation-based, informative tour. Guests learn about the indigenous wild cats of South Africa and why they are disappearing from our landscape.

A variety of indigenous birds, such as Blue Cranes, Marabou Storks and waterfowls frequent the gardens of Tenikwa, the extent of which covers some 8ha with the balance of the 46ha set aside for the wild animals occurring in the area.



Situated in the coastal town of Plettenberg Bay (20 minutes from Knysna), Ocean Blue Adventure offers a rare and powerful experience through permitted boat based whale watching and dolphin encounters. All tours are guided with expert crew and tour operators who are internationally qualified. Ocean Blue is a licensed SABBWWA permit holder, which enables us to approach whales from 50 metres instead of 300 metres. Should the whales approach our vessel we do not have to move away. The guests therefore get an up close experience with these majestic mammals in the bay.
