Facts about **Botswana**

* **Republic of Botswana**

Botswana became an independent country on 30 September 1966. It is a multi-party democracy, governed by an Executive President. The current President is His Excellency Lieutenant General Seretse Khama Ian Khama.

* **Population**

The total population is estimated at 1.85 million growing at a rate of 3.5% per annum.

* **Language**

The official language is English, which is used in government and business. Setswana is the national language and is widely spoken. Other ethnic groups speak their own languages.

* **Climate**

Summer December to March. High temperatures average 30C to 35C with lows around 18C. Rain particularly in December and February. Winter June to August. Daytime temperatures around 23C with night time lows averaging 5C.

* **Geography**

Botswana's surface area consists of 581,730 sq km. Botswana's is completely landlocked, bordered by its neighbours South Africa, Namibia, Zambia and Zimbabwe.

* **Currency**

Botswana's currency is the Pula. The Pula is divided into 100 thebe.

Notes - P200, P100, P20 and P10.

Coins - P5, P2 and P1. Thebe - 50t, 25t, 10t and 5t.

Facts about **Namibia**

* **Republic of Namibia**

Namibia became an independent country on 21 March 1990. It is ruled by a Multi Party Parliament. The current president Hifikupunye Pohamba was elected in November 2004.

* **Population**

The total population is about 2 million people growing at a rate of 2.6% per annum.

* **Language**

While English is the official language, many other languages are spoken. They can be divided into three categories: the Bantu languages spoken by the Ovambo, Herero, Kaango, Caprivians and Tswana; the indo Germanic languages of Afrikaans, German and English; and the Khoisan languages spoken by the San/Bushmen and Nama/Damara. Indigenous languages include Oshivambo, Herero and Nama.

* **Climate**

Summer October to April. High temperatures average at about 30C and can go up to 34C with lows 15C to 25C. Temperatures above 40C are recorded in the extreme north and south of the country.

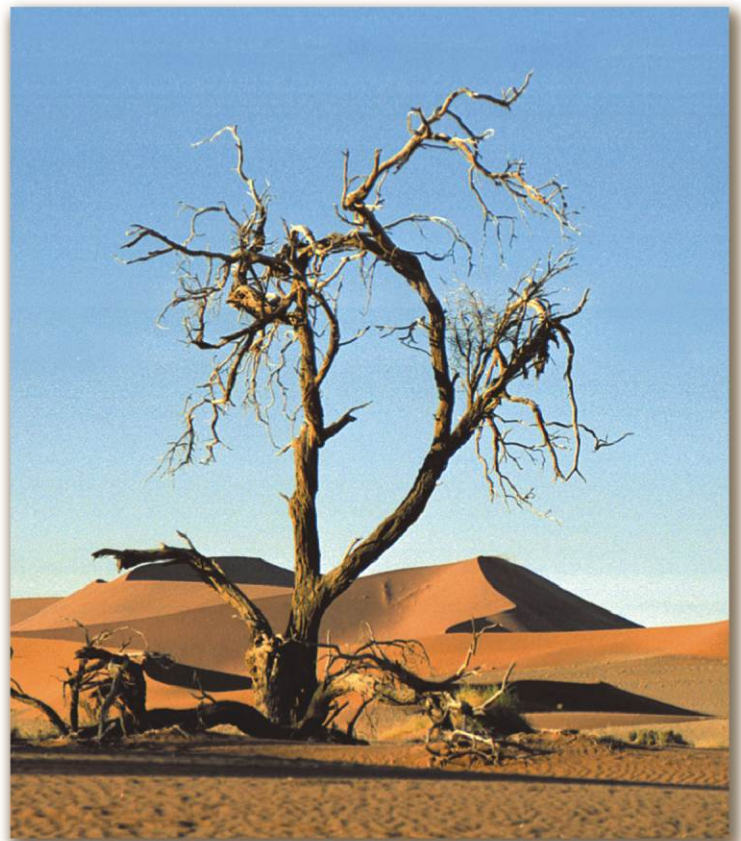
Winter May to September. High temperatures are between 18C to 25C during the day. The average night temperatures are from 0C to 10C.

* **Geography**

Namibia lies in Southern Africa, on the South Atlantic Ocean Coast. The bordering countries are Angola, Botswana, South Africa and Zambia. Surface area is 824,268 sq km.

* **Currency**

The currency of Namibia is the Namibian Dollar (N\$), which is related to the South African Rand (exchange rate 1:1). The South African Rand can also be used for payment. One N\$ is divided into 100 dollar cents. Notes N\$200, 100, 50, 20 and 10. Coins N\$5, N\$1, Cents 50, 10 and 5.

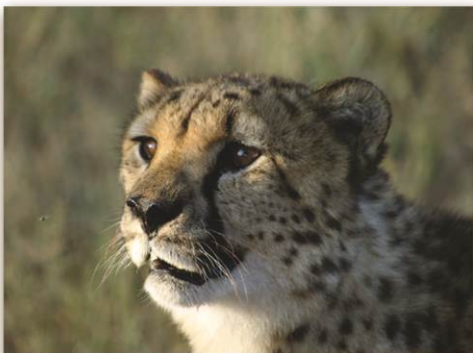
Day 1: Windhoek

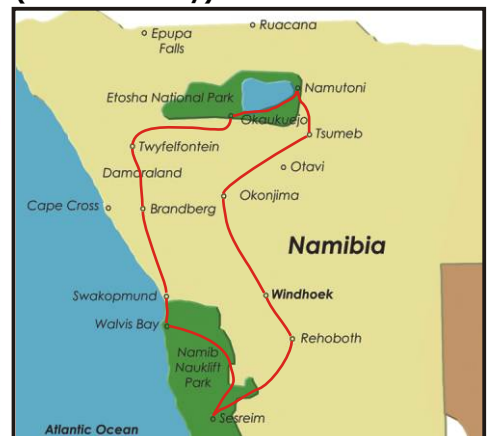

Day 1: Windhoek

The Epupa Falls are a series of cascades where the Kunene River drops 60m in 1.5km forming a multitude of channels and rock pools. A variety of birds can be seen in the area. Standard Mobile Safari **(All meals)**



Day 7: Kaokoland Opuwo

During the morning we visit a Himba village to gain a glimpse into their way of life. The Himbas are a semi-nomadic tribe, who live in scattered settlements throughout the region. We arrive in Opuwo, the capital of Kaokoland, in the afternoon. Ohakane Lodge (or similar accommodation) **(All meals)**



Day 8: Damaraland

An early morning drive takes us to our camp in Damaraland- one of the last true wilderness areas in Africa. The changing colours of the surrounding landscapes are enjoyed on a guided walk with explanations of the unique flora and geology of the area. Standard Mobile Safari **(All meals)**

Day 9: Twyfelfontein-Brandberg

We visit the Twyfelfontein area a UNESCO World Heritage Site with over 2000 rock carvings and walk to view the ancient Bushman rock engravings. We stay at the foot of Brandberg Mountain. Brandberg White Lady Lodge (or similar accommodation) **(All meals)**

Day 10: Swakopmund

On our way to Swakopmund, we visit Cape Cross Seal Colony, one of the largest mainland seal colonies in the world. Swakopmund, with its German colonial atmosphere, is the principal coastal resort of Namibia. Time is spent at leisure to enjoy the charm of this old town or to undertake one of the many optional activities on offer. Overnight accommodation in Guest House **(All meals, excluding dinner)**

Day 11: Namib Naukluft Park

We spend the morning in Swakopmund. After lunch (own account) we depart to the Namib-Naukluft Park. We spend the night at the foot of the Namib Desert on the Kuiseb River. In the late afternoon our guide will take us on a nature walk on the dune belt with the opportunity to spot a range of desert-adapted plants and animals. Standard Mobile Safari (Breakfast and dinner only)

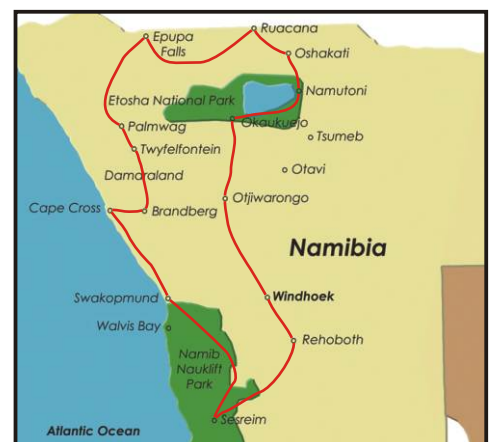
Day 12/13: Namib Desert- Sossusvlei

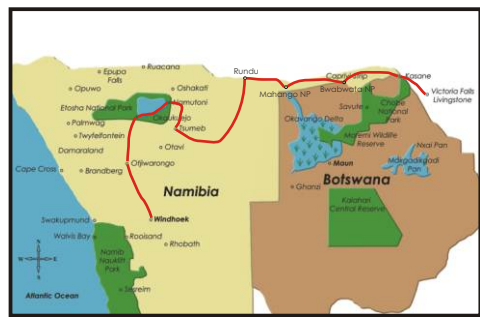

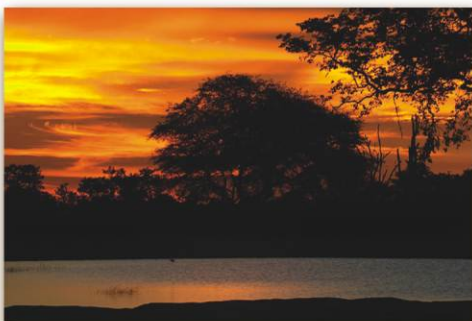
Day 1: Kasane - Chobe National Park

General Information

Namibia & Botswana

1. SAFARI DOSSIER:

A dossier detailing climate, recommended clothing, visas etc. will be forwarded to the participants or tour operator/travel agent after confirmation of the reservation.

It is absolutely essential that each participant receive a copy of the dossier before traveling.

2. ITINERARIES:

Please note that itineraries will depend on local conditions.

Participants should be aware that traveling in Africa is sometimes unpredictable.

3. CLIMATIC CONDITIONS:

The winter nights in southern Africa (May to September) are very cold with pleasant days. Warm clothing is essential for this time of year.

4. LUGGAGE:

Luggage is limited to 12kg + 1 camera bag per person. **Any luggage in excess of 12kg or large suitcases will not be loaded onto the vehicle.** We recommend the use of a soft canvas barrel bag. We advise all participants to follow the airline rules and regulations regarding their toiletries and medication. Passengers who have a connecting flight should collect their luggage at each airport to avoid the risk of luggage loss whilst in transit.

NB: For itineraries that include a light aircraft scenic flight/transfer, luggage is limited to 12kg in soft barrel bag.

5. BEDDING:

On all Serviced Camping Safaris a sleeping bag / bed roll, and small pillow are provided. Clients traveling during the winter months of May - September may wish to bring an additional small blanket as temperatures in certain areas drop considerably at night.

6. PERSONAL EFFECTS:

Travel light with light, casual clothing for the day and a jersey or tracksuit for the evenings. (A warm jacket is essential for winter months). Do not take along too much clothing. Take a good pair of walking shoes. Do not forget a torch, water bottle, swimsuit, hat, sun block cream, binoculars and camera. Allow enough money for souvenirs, evenings out, drinks, special excursions and personal expenses.

7. TRAVEL DOCUMENTS:

You will require a valid passport with 2 blank pages for entry into South Africa. Please check with us, your local consulate or travel agent as to visa, passport, and health requirements. It is your responsibility to ensure that your passport, visas, and vaccination certificates are all in order before departure. We cannot be held liable for any passenger being refused entry into a country for any reason whatsoever.

8. HEALTH:

You must be in good health to undertake any safari. We visit remote areas with little or no medical facilities. Our safaris are not strenuous and anybody leading a moderately active lifestyle can participate. Our safari consultants will advise you on the safari best suited to you.

 No show on day of departure: 100% of the total fare (regardless of circumstances)

14. ADMINISTRATION FEES:

An Administration/ Communication fee of Euro 40 will be applicable when altering a reservation 41 days or more before departure. Cancellation fees will be applicable for cancellation within 41 days before departure.

15. INDEMNITY:

All participants traveling on a Karibu Safari are required to complete and sign an Indemnity Form before joining the safari.

16. COMPLAINTS:

Should participants have a complaint whilst on safari, the clients must inform the tour leader in order that they may attempt to rectify the matter. 17. HOTEL ACCOMMODATION, AIRFARES, PARKING:

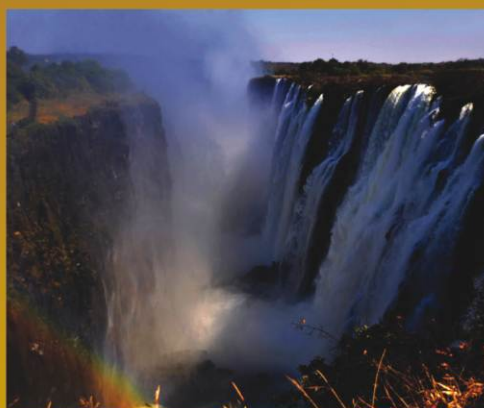
