



Budongo Eco Lodge is an eco-friendly accommodation situated in the Budongo Forest Reserve of Murchison Falls National Park. We're an award winning facility providing rustic but comfortable cabins and a wide range of authentic forest activities.

Location:

The lodge is at Kaniyo Pabidi, in the north-eastern part of Budongo Forest Reserve which is located within the southern boundaries of the Park. Only 29 km from Masindi town and 9 km from the Park gates.

Directions/Getting there:

From Masindi town, turn right at the Shell petrol station on to a murram road. After 6 km, turn left and continue driving until you reach a fork road. Take the road on the left heading to Murchison Falls National Park and after 14km you will meet Kuchobonyobo gate which is the main gate to the park. From there, Budongo Eco Lodge (Kaniyo Pabidi) is just 8kms away.

Note: After Murchison Falls National Park main gate please get your cameras out and get ready to be welcomed by troops of baboons enjoying the sun right in the middle of the road if you are in luck!

All en suite, with a private veranda
- 4 Dormitory rooms
Each with 2 double-decker beds and shared facilities

Power supply:

The main lodge and rooms are equipped with controlled 240v solar powered electricity with a backup generator. However due to the environment, the solar system may not charge as expected. In this case kerosene lanterns are provided at the reception. We kindly request you to use the power in an eco-friendly way and turn off the lights when leaving the room.

Adapters:

Mobiles phones, cameras, iPads, laptops and other electronics can be charged at the main lodge. Our plug-in to mains are British three type plug outlets.

Security and Wildlife:

Please note that Budongo Eco Lodge is situated in a wildlife habitat. We therefore kindly request you to leave your doors closed after entering or leaving your room.

Please do not bring food into the rooms as it might attract ants or other animals.

Please notify one of our staff members to accompany you when leaving or returning to your room after dusk.
