



Lodge Summary:

Lodge Description: Heuglin's Lodge is situated in the peaceful garden suburbs of Lilongwe's residential area, yet is in a prime location being just 5 minutes from Capital City and just 35 minutes from Lilongwe International Airport. The Lodge offers a variety of spacious and tastefully furnished bedrooms accommodating up to a maximum of 18 people providing a perfect base for both visitors and business consultants alike.

Facilities: The lodge has 9 spacious rooms, broadband internet access, TV's in rooms, TV lounge with self service bar, fine dining, swimming pool, extensive gardens, transfer service within Lilongwe, airport transfers and a wildlife library. For business guests a business centre with broadband internet, photocopying, printing and faxing facilities are available.

Seasons: Non seasonal

Child Policy: Children of all ages are welcome.

Accommodation:

Heuglin's Lodge takes a maximum of 18 guests.

En-suite rooms – Total 8: The elegantly styled rooms are comfortable and tastefully furnished. En-suite facilities include shower or bath.

Rooms (sharing bathroom) – Total 1: The lodge has 1 room with non-en-suite bathroom.

Room details:

Each room has a television and access to wireless broadband internet. Mosquito nets, insect repellent and amenities are supplied in each room.

Meals:

Meals are served in the lodge verandah overlooking the beautiful pool and gardens. A varied menu of excellent home cooked cuisine is prepared on a daily basis, using locally sourced food to cater to guest needs.

About Lilongwe:

Lilongwe became Malawi's Capital City after Independence in 1964.

The city is split into 2 clear parts-the old city, dating from the 1920's and the Capital City which was built after Malawi's Independence. The Capital City is quite unique. Separated from the Old Town by a 5 kms wooded 'no development' zone, one has the feeling of being in a leafy suburb. There are some impressive Embassy buildings and government offices and even a small, well-tended Nature Sanctuary which is well worth a walk around, particularly for keen birdwatchers.

There is a reasonable variety of restaurant options, including al-fresco dining, making the most of the benign climate and lush vegetation.

In 2006, a mausoleum was opened as a tribute to the late Hastings Kamuzu Banda. This is situated adjacent to the war memorial as well as the site of the new Parliament house which is currently under construction.
