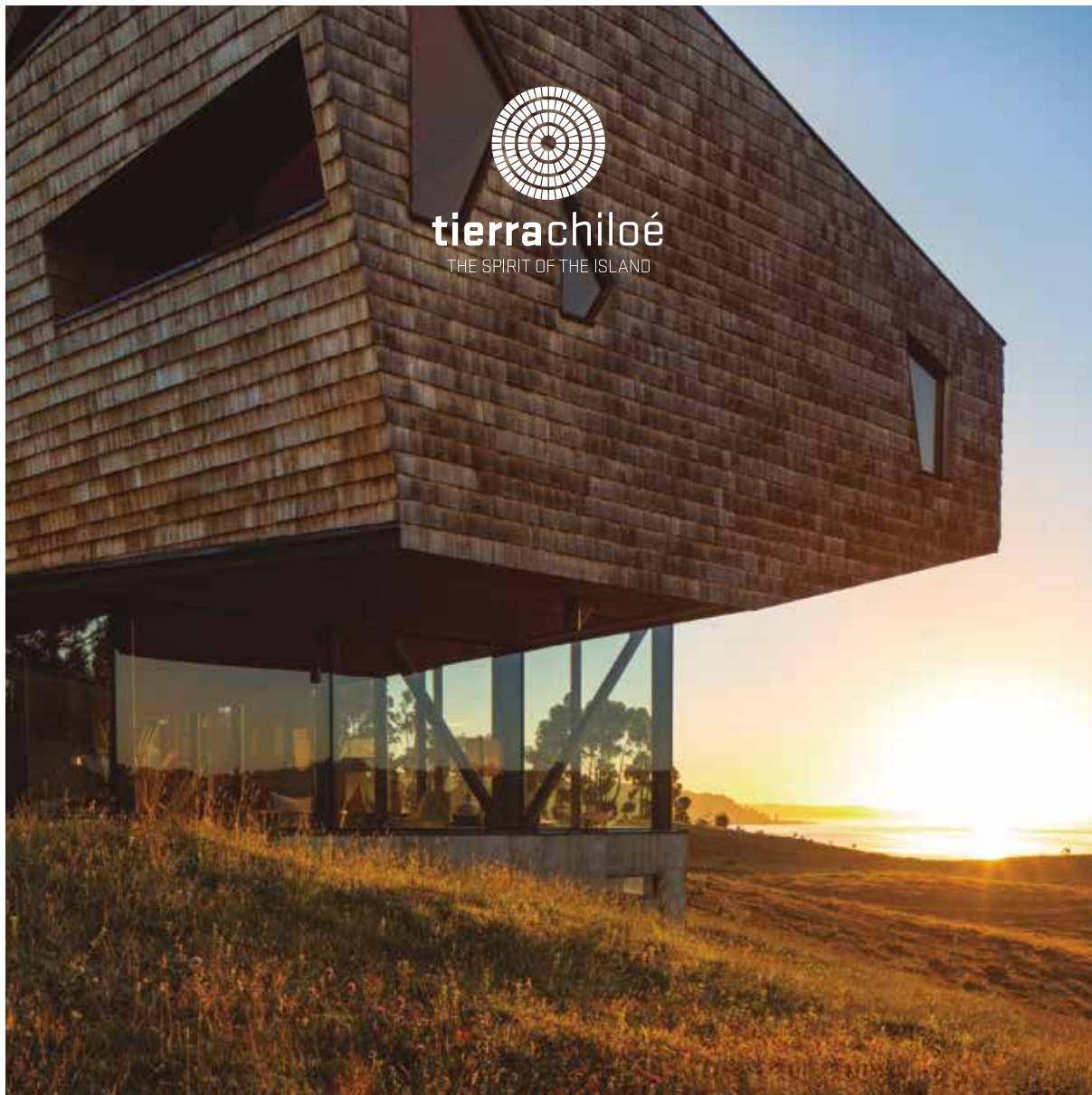

TIERRA CHILOÉ

Tierra Chiloé is a welcoming lodge on the island of Chiloé, off the coast of Northern Patagonia. Sitting on 10 hectares of land where the sea meets the countryside, the hotel overlooks the islands of the southern archipelago. A journey here is as much about the island's rich and magical culture as it is about its beautiful landscapes. Our aim is to inspire guests to explore the hills and blue waters as well as experience the timeless traditions of the island's people.

HOTEL DESIGN & FACILITIES

The immensity of the inland Pacific is on display from every angle at Tierra Chiloé. Built with a sustainable geometric design which reflects the traditional "palafitos" of the island (houses on stilts over the sea), the hotel is intimate and inviting. Interiors are carefully decorated with hand-made textiles and woodcarvings, echoing the island's culture. Views include a myriad of smaller islands and the Andes mountains in the distance. Facilities include reading, dining, and living rooms, an excursion area, TV lounge, terrace, and outdoor lounge with fireplace. There is also a relaxation area with Jacuzzi, sauna, and steam room. WiFi is available throughout the hotel.

ROOMS

The 12 Superior rooms (30m², 332 sq. feet) each have a panoramic view from the upper

floor of the ever-changing light over the ocean. Warm and cozy, the decoration includes hand-dyed rugs and throws woven from local lambswool.

Bathrooms have showers and Jacuzzi tubs, and every room has a telephone, hairdryer and safe.

ADVENTURES & EXCURSIONS

The hotel offers a select choice of tailored excursions designed to reveal the magic of the island. Guests can visit the UNESCO World Heritage churches, famous for their wooden shingles and unique design and enjoy wandering through local markets where everything from fresh fish to handmade textiles are on display. Exploring the islands can be done by foot, horse, bike and kayak. Bird watching is a popular option as the property is located next to wetlands, which are home to a variety of migratory birds. In addition, the lodge offers exclusive trips through the fiords and canals on its traditional vessel the "Williche."

FOOD & WINE

Food is inspired by the traditional dishes of Chiloé and locally sourced produce includes succulent oysters, farm fresh eggs and, straight from the surrounding waters, the daily catch. Chiloé's traditional cuisine includes Curanto, a stew of shellfish, fish, potatoes and meat, cooked on hot stones in the ground. The food served is simple, local and delicious. Guests can also enjoy an extensive list of Chilean wines, artisan beers and classic cocktails.

SUSTAINABILITY

With the premise that any project has an impact on the immediate environment, the aim with Tierra Chiloé was to create a hotel that is in step with its surroundings. After a careful study of climatic conditions on the

property, the hotel's design was channeled to optimize natural resources including wind, sunlight and rainwater. Borrowing from the island's carpentry traditions, the exterior was clad in wooden shingles to ensure a low level of heat loss. The local community was key during the construction phase and continues to be an integral part of the hotel.

LOCATION & SEASONALITY

Open from spring through until the end of fall (September – May) Tierra Chiloé closes during the southern hemisphere winter months (May – August) The nearest airport is Mocopulli – Castro (MHC), 30 minutes drive away. Commercial flights from Chile's capital, Santiago, land several times a week. Flight time is 2 ½ hours approximately.

The airport at Puerto Montt (PMC) receives a number of flights daily from Santiago (2 hour flight) and is approximately 3 hours' drive from the hotel. The nearest village is San José, and the hotel is 18km (11 miles) from Castro, the island's capital.
