## TRAVEL INFORMATION

### WHAT TO PACK:

- The dress code for dinner is smart casual
- A light jacket in summer and a thick jacket in winter
- A waterproof light windsheeter is recommended when visiting the Victoria Falls during high water months
- Medication for allergies
- Zambia is a malaria area and it is advised to use malaria prophylaxis, plus consult your doctor or pharmacist regarding recommended brands
- Sunscreen and sunglasses are recommended all year round
- Binoculars for birding and game viewing are an added bonus
- Guests must obtain a yellow fever inoculation before departing their own country

## GENERAL INFORMATION

Insect repellent is provided in suites and public areas and all suites are furnished with mosquito nets.

### CURRENCY:

- Zambia's local currency is the Kwacha (ZMW).

### TIPPING/GRATUITY:

- Tipping is an integral part of African life and tips are expected for services that you might take for granted at home.
- Tipping is only recommended if you are satisfied with the service you received and is entirely at your own discretion.

#### VISAS/PASSPORTS:

- South African residents and SADEC passport holders do not need a visa, but require a valid passport to enter Zambia
- All non-SADEC passport holders require a visa to enter Zambia
- Visas can be purchased upon arrival at Livingstone at US\$ 50 per visa. It is however recommended that a dual-entry visa is
- purchased at a cost of US\$ 80 to allow one to either enter Zimbabwe or Botswana for some of the activities listed above.
- Both visas must be paid for in ZMW (Kwacha), which can be withdrawn from the Airport Arrivals ATM.
- Certain countries are NOT permitted to obtain visas at the port of entry and must therefore apply in advance to a Zambian
- Mission or directly to the Chief Immigration officer at Immigration headquarters in Lusaka, Zambia.

#### TRANSFERS:

- A return transfer between Livingstone International Airport is included in the accommodation packaged rates; any alternative transfer can be arranged with central reservations at an additional cost.

#### ARRIVING:

- A lodge representative will meet all guests at Livingstone International upon arrival
- Guests are transferred in a private, air-conditioned minibus to:
- River lodge (45 to 50 minutes)
- The bush harbor followed by a boat trip (5 to 10 minutes) to Island
