Here one can relax on African day beds and cool off in an infinity pool that overhangs a pristine riverine system where game abounds.





Each of the six ensuite bedrooms with private outside showers open onto their own deck looking over the untouched African Bush. The teak internal bedroom doors were sourced in Lamu and the carved four poster beds come from Mombasa. The furnishings can be described as eclectic. Bright coloured silks and leathers have been used and expensive antiques, Persian rugs and objects d'art add to the exotic look of this villa. Hand made linen is used throughout.

The villa has its own game drive vehicle, ranger, tracker, chef, butler and housekeeping staff and has the same services and standards as Royal Malewane. Guests are welcome to make use of the Royal Malewane shop and award winning spa.
