





PRE-DEPARTURE CHECKLIST FOR YOUR SPECIFIC SAFARI TO ZAMBIA

Passport		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Expiration date: must be valid for 6 months after the date of departure from Zambia ▪ Zambia require two blank passport pages and an additional blank page if transiting South Africa
Visa		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ No visa required for entry to Zambia
Covid Vaccination Certificate / Covid PCR test certificate		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No Covid vaccination or Covid PCR test requirements on entry to Zambia.
Yellow Fever		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Yellow Fever: Not required for entry into Zambia unless travelers have visited or transited through a destination where Yellow Fever is prevalent
Malaria		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Malaria is prevalent in parts of Zambia, and all visitors should consult a medical practitioner for advice on the most suitable prophylactics to take
Travel Insurance		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Adequate travel insurance is essential in the event of medical emergencies evacuation and cancellation
Departure to US		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ <i>Where applicable:</i> Travelers are required to abide by the regulations of the airline they are travelling with and the onward transit / destination entry requirements
Travelkey App 		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Download the Travel Key App from Google Play Store & the App Store ▪ Enter your mobile code (password) as indicated on your itinerary Overview page
WhatsApp 		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Download the WhatsApp messenger app for smartphones ▪ WhatsApp Messenger, or simply WhatsApp, allows users to send text messages and voice messages, make voice and video calls, and share images, documents, user locations, and other content when using Wi-Fi and the internet at no cost instead of using cellular data-networks where fees may apply. Most safari lodges and hotels now have Wi-Fi.
