Entry requirements

What documents do you need when visiting Zambia?

- **Passport:** valid for at least six months after the intended date of departure from Zambia and to include at least two blank pages
- **NOTE:** In the case of one parent accompanying a minor (under 18 years), a valid passport must be provided.
- **Visa: No Visa requirements for entry to Zambia.**
- **No Covid requirements for entry to Zambia**
- A **health declaration form** must be completed and handed in upon arrival in Zambia. These forms should be distributed on the aircraft, if not they will be available at the point of entry. We advise completing the form in advance and you can download one [here](#).

Departure Requirements

- Travelers are required to abide by the regulations of the airline they are travelling with and the onward transit / destination entry requirements

Health Precautions

- **Malaria is prevalent** in some of the areas to be visited. Please consult your physician for suitable anti-malaria medication
- **Note:** Please refer to the CDC website for advice on anti-malaria medication recommended for different countries as certain types of malaria may be resistant to medication prescribed. https://www.cdc.gov/malaria/travelers/country_table/a.html
- **No Yellow Fever vaccination** required for these 3 countries (unless visiting high alert destinations for longer than a 12 hour stay pre arrival)
- **No Yellow Fever** required for entry to Zambia if travelling from South Africa, Botswana and Zimbabwe
