**Day 1: Atzaró Cape Town, Cape Town (Fri, May 16)**

### South Africa

One of the most culturally and geographically diverse places on earth, South Africa, fondly known by locals as the 'Rainbow Nation', boasts 11 official languages, and its inhabitants are influenced by a fascinating mix of cultures. Discover the gourmet restaurants, impressive art scene, vibrant nightlife, and beautiful beaches of Cape Town. Enjoy a local braai (barbecue) in the Soweto township, browse the bustling Indian markets in Durban, or sample some of the world's finest wines at the myriad wine estates dotting the Cape Winelands. Some historical attractions to explore include the Zululand battlefields of KwaZulu-Natal, the Apartheid Museum in Johannesburg, and Robben Island, just off the coast of Cape Town. Above all else, its untamed wilderness is astonishing: wildlife roams freely across massive unfenced game reserves such as the world-famous Kruger National Park.

## Cape Town

Set at the confluence of the Indian and Atlantic oceans and backed by the iconic Table Mountain, the bustling city of Cape Town presents an alluring combination of drawcards. Incredible powdery white beaches, highly acclaimed wine routes, and astonishingly beautiful mountain trails surround a cosmopolitan hub. This diverse metropolis is filled with superb shops and restaurants, extraordinary heritage monuments, a multitude of entertainment venues, and a spectacular, chic waterfront harbour. Highlights include the Zeitz Museum of Contemporary African Art; Table Mountain's jaw-dropping views; Boulders Beach, where penguins might swim right up to you in the warm Indian ocean waters; the Kirstenbosch Botanical Gardens, where you can walk along a treetop canopy among incredible native flora or watch an open-air concert at the base of the mountain; Robben Island, where visitors can see the cell where Nelson Mandela was imprisoned for 18 years; and many more.

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## Day Itinerary

Arrive Cape Town International Airport.

*United and Delta have direct flights to Cape Town, from Newark, Washington DC and Atlanta. Alternatively, flights via Europe are an option on several European airlines, including British Airways, Virgin, Air France, KLM, Lufthansa, Turkish and others.*

Clear South Africa immigration, Americans do not require a visa. Once you have collected your luggage, make your way to the arrival hall. You will be met in the arrival hall by Dawn Feuerberg your trip leader, and a driver for a road transfer to Atzaro Cape Town.

Welcome to Africa's Mother City!

Drive time to the private villa is about 30 minutes.

\*The program starts at the Atzaro Villa at **5:00pm** today. Check-in available from 3:00pm.

Settle in, take in the views of the mountain, and city below. You have the remainder of the day or evening to meet up with group, and discuss your adventure ahead.

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## **Day 4: Thamo Telele, Maun (Mon, May 19)**

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### **Botswana**

Situated in the southern reaches of Africa, Botswana is renowned for its pristine wilderness areas characterised by deep lagoons, wetlands, lush palms, rugged hills and desert plains. The country's primary tourist drawcard is undoubtedly the vast red expanse of the Kalahari Desert and its remarkably beautiful Okavango Delta, the largest inland delta in the world. These natural wonders provide a tranquil haven for an abundance of African wildlife to thrive. Other highlights include the impressive Makgadikgadi Salt Pans, where visitors are privy to massive zebra migrations during the flood season; the Savuti plains, which host a significant pride of lions; and the Tsodilo Hills, where 4500 rock paintings form a unique record of human settlement over many millennia.

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### **Maun**

Set on the banks of the beautiful Thamalakane River in northern Botswana, Maun is the third-largest town in this spectacularly scenic southern African country. Maun is the starting point for most expeditions into the Okavango Delta and as a result, has developed into a bustling metropolis that is considered Botswana's tourism capital. Area attractions include a renowned riverboat that offers cruises up and down the Thamalakane River; the forest groves of the Maun Game Reserve; and Moremi Game Reserve, home to hippos, lions and rhinos. Maun also serves as the jumping-off point for many safaris and air charters as well as offering private 4x4 rentals. Don't miss the opportunity to visit the Nhabe Museum exhibiting the local history, art and culture of the Ngamiland region.

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### **Day Itinerary**

Breakfast at Atzaro and check out.

A driver will collect you for the transfer to Cape Town Airport. Check in to your flight to Maun (2hr30min flight).

Arrive in Maun, Botswana. You will be met in the arrival hall and once you have cleared Botswana customs.  
*Americans and Canadians do not require a visa.*

Welcome to Botswana! A driver will transfer you by road to Thamo Telele Lodge, which is located just outside of Maun, on a nature reserve.

In the afternoon, you will start easing into safari life and getting in touch with Africa's nature. Enjoy a guided walk through the reserve to encounter the local giraffe herd. Dawn will lead a session in the tranquil forest surrounded by bird song and the reserves native wildlife, such as zebras, antelopes and giraffe.

### ***One night at Thamo Telele***

#### **Overnight: Thamo Telele**

Thamo Telele is a private game reserve located twenty minutes from the iconic safari town of Maun, the gateway to the Okavango Delta.

The lodge is situated on a private reserve on the banks of the Thamalakane River with an abundance of wildlife including giraffe, zebra, springbok, ostrich, eland, gemsbok and kudu as well as an extensive variety of bird life.

Guests will indulge in comfort and relaxation in one of Thamo Telele's well appointed, private tented chalets or romantic thatched honeymoon suites. World class cuisine served by candlelight on the lodge's expansive teak deck, is the perfect way to conclude a day's safari.

At Thamo Telele, it's not just about luxurious accommodation and old world hospitality. Marked walking trails invite guests to create their own adventure allowing safe, intimate interaction with wildlife. For the more adventurous, set off on a horse back safari, scenic flight over the delta, or mokoro canoe trip down the river.

Finish off the day with a warm drink around the communal fire as personal safari hosts and Thamo Telele managers share life stories from over 80 years of combined safari experience.

#### ***Giraffe Experience***

Come and have high-tea with our herd of 20 resident giraffe! A real highlight when staying at Thamo Telele. Take a afternoon drive (or walk) to the local waterhole, perch yourself peacefully under the trees enjoying a sundowner and snacks, and wait for our unique ungulates to come and say hello. This is an ideal opportunity to closely observe giraffe displaying their natural behaviours. And whilst the giraffe are feeding, a whole host of other plains game and birdlife will join in on the action too. This unique experience, led by our naturalists on hand, is one not to be missed. You'll learn all about giraffe conservation throughout Africa and the education programmes at Thamo Telele, as well as how to identify each giraffe by their unique patterning. Each of them has a Setswana name, and if in doubt there is an identification book for referencing to get it right.

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**Day 5-7: Camp Kalahari, Makgadikgadi Salt Pans (Tue, May 20 to Thu, May 22)**

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**Makgadikgadi Salt Pans**

Set in the heart of the dry savanna of northeastern Botswana, the Makgadikgadi Pan is the world's largest network of salt pans stretching over 3900 square kilometres and formed on the bed of the ancient Makgadikgadi Lake that began evaporating aeons ago. Visiting Makgadikgadi is a unique salt desert experience: in the dry season, this vast expanse of sun-baked salt glistens in the light, and when the rains come, the pan is home to a cornucopia of flamingos and other waterbirds, as well as one of Africa's largest zebra populations, whose annual migration is a wonder to behold. Visitors can immerse themselves in the stark beauty of this incredible landscape, spot a host of wildlife and enjoy a number of activities, including horse riding safaris, game drives, and excellent birdwatching. Other highlights include: quad biking across the vast expanse of dry salt pans or jumping in a helicopter and viewing countless flamingo flocks creating a magnificent pink spectacle dotting the landscape.

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**Day Itinerary**

After breakfast at Thamo Telele, you will be transferred to the airport, where you will connect with a scheduled light air flight to the Kalahari Desert. Flying time is about one hour. On arrival at the airstrip, you are met by your guide for game drive transfer to Camp Kalahari, located on a tree island on the edge of the vast Makgadikgadi salt pans. Arrive at the camp in time for lunch and an afternoon activity.

Activities possible from Camp Kalahari, include safari game drives in search of desert wildlife such as as zebra, oryx, springbok, lions and more. If there is still water in the pans, large herds of migrating zebra can be seen. Educational walks with local Bushman people are also a highlight. These spiritual people will give you a glimpse into survival in the desert.

Dawn will lead sessions in this amazing landscape.

**Two nights Camp Kalahari****Expert Tips**

*Inter camp flights within Botswana are operated by either Cessna 206 which seat 4 passengers, Airvan that seats 8, or Cessna 208, which seats 10. Or by helicopter. For safety reasons, these flights have strict luggage limits. You are allowed a maximum of 20kgs (44lbs) per person, in soft sided bags. The luggage compartments are small, and bags must be able to be manipulated into the tight spaces. If you have excess luggage, there are services in Johannesburg that can store bags for you, whilst on safari. We will provide you with all the necessary luggage requirement information.*

*Your inter-camp flights are on a scheduled (not private) basis, and may involve stops enroute at other safari camps to drop off or collect other passengers. Flight times are determined the day before, and the camp manager will notify you as to what time your flights are.*

## Overnight: Camp Kalahari

Camp Kalahari sits among acacias and Mokolwane palms on the edge of the Makgadikgadi Salt Pans. A relaxed, family-friendly camp, ideal for those seeking fun and adventure, without sacrificing comfort or style.

The camp is an eclectic mix of original African furnishings paired with traditional campaign furniture and colonial antiques. Guests can relax in the traditional lounge/dining area, or cool off in the large swimming pool. All 12 spacious Meru tents - 6 twin, 4 double and 2 family tents, are en-suite and furnished with rich textiles, Moroccan kilims, and four poster beds.

Guests can enjoy a range of year-round activities: Get up close and personal with a gang of friendly habituated meerkats; walk with Zu//hoasi Bushmen for a glimpse into their ancient culture; game drive to experience unique desert wildlife; visit the Fallen Baobab, campsite of Livingstone & Selous and one of Africa's three largest, oldest trees.

Dry season only: quad bike across the lunar expanse of the pans; lie out on the pans as the sun sets; watch the planetarium show unfold with horizon-to-horizon stars.

Wet season only: experience the spectacular migration of zebra and wildebeest, the second biggest in Africa and the last remaining in Southern Africa.

### *Walking with Meerkats at Camp Kalahari*

Get up close and personal with our families of habituated meerkats. Head out from camp at sunrise, so that you are ready to tail these delightful omnivores as they set off in search of their breakfast. Walk amongst them (advised by your guide) and if you take a seat you might be lucky enough to be mistaken for a termite mound, where you'll be used as a look out point for predators.

### *Camp Kalahari Bushmen Walk*

Spend time walking with a group of Zu//hoasi Bushmen for a glimpse into their ancient culture, understanding how they use the flora and fauna to survive in this sparse environment.

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## Day 7-10: Mokolwane, Okavango Delta (Thu, May 22 to Sun, May 25)

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### Okavango Delta

Situated in the northwestern corner of Botswana, the Okavango Delta is a World Heritage Site as it is the largest inland delta in the world. The magnificent Okavango River sprawls out over the dry sands of the Kalahari Desert forming this flourishing waterlogged oasis featuring countless meandering waterways and crystal clear lagoons studded with water lilies, as well as fertile floodplains and reeded islands inhabited with abundant wildlife. The Okavango Delta stretches over an impressive 15000 square kilometres. Visitors can enjoy a number of wonderful activities such as game viewing, fishing, bird watching or taking an authentic guided Mokoro excursion through this wetland paradise in a traditional dugout canoe. Commonly spotted animals include: lion, rhino, leopard, giraffe, hippos, elephants, crocodiles and countless species of bird.

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### Day Itinerary

After a morning activity and breakfast, you will be transferred to the airstrip, for your light aircraft flight back to Maun. On arrival in Maun, you are met and assisted to your scheduled helicopter flight to your next safari camp in the Okavango Delta. Mokolwane Camp is only accessible by helicopter. Flying over the Okavango in a helicopter is the ideal way to appreciate this vast wetland, as you can spot wildlife from the air.

Arrive at Mokolwane in time for lunch and an afternoon safari activity.

Enjoy three days of exciting safari activities on this private concession in the middle of the Okavango. There is a wide range of wildlife to be seen, including all the big cats, elephants, buffalo, hippo and more.

The Okavango is a very spiritual place, and you will feel well removed from everyday life in this peaceful wilderness area. Dawn leads sessions in amazing natural surroundings.

### *Three nights at Mokolwane*

### Expert Tips

*The Okavango Delta is one of Africa's most iconic safari destinations. An inland watery wilderness, made up of clear flowing rivers, palm islands and open plains. It is surrounded by a semi desert. Wildlife viewing is exceptional, with all the species present, including herds of elephants, hippos, prides of lion and more. A Botswana safari is also about*

*being on private concessions, so you see few other people, and often have vast wildlife areas to yourselves. It's an incredible experience!*

### **Overnight: Mokolwane**

Situated on the Matsebi River, Mokolwane camp is made up of tree houses 2 metres off the ground. A real haven for elephants that love the palm trees of this area. This camp is situated in the open flood plains that receive floodwater 3 weeks earlier than the southern areas of the concession. The vegetation consists of smaller palm islands and wide-open spaces.

Mokolwane is a 14-bedded camp, with the accommodation boasting superb views, each with a private bathroom. The Matsebi River is your main feeder for Lake Ngami, which is historically famous to the region.

One of the remotest camps in the Okavango Delta. For certain parts of the year the camp is only accessible on foot. This really is one of the earth's last wildernesses. A place to take in all the noise of nature from your raised tree cabin. A simple but beautiful camp.

## **Day 10-12: Little Sable, Khwai Private Reserve (Sun, May 25 to Tue, May 27)**

### **Khwai Private Reserve**

Welcome to Khwai Private Reserve, 440 000 acres bordering onto both the Moremi Game Reserve and Chobe National Park in northern Botswana. It is an innovative community based joint venture partnership that adjoins onto the world famous Okavango Delta eco-system. The Reserve was established to create a meaningful bridge between the tourism industry and local villagers, ensuring significant economic income for local communities, first world environmentally sensitive practices and a superb safari experience. The massive Khwai Private Reserve comprises of

some of the most fantastically diverse habitats in northern Botswana, including riverine woodlands, floodplains, open savannah, mopane woodland, rivers and lagoons. This range of habitats results in a range of wildlife, including elephant, lion, leopard, wild dog, cheetah and of course the eponymous sable antelope.

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### **Day Itinerary**

Breakfast and a morning game drive from Mokolwane, and then the helicopter will collect you for a flight across the Okavango to Little Sable in the north. Land at Little Sable in time for lunch and an afternoon safari game drive.
